## CORRESPONDENCE

06/05/2026 Resident & allotment holder.

I wish to ask that whilst negotiations take place with the landowner for the new lease of the land which sites Woolmer Green Allotments, that there is also an additional clause if agreeable to you all and them.

As a medical herbalist and occupational therapist, I would like to be able to utilise my plot and the herbs upon it for the community to use. I would if agreeable like to be able to run community sessions to help others learn about biodiversity, the various methods for gardening and the herbs that may help them should they choose to grow them.

I originally put this proposal to the Allotment Association but was told that this idea was against the current lease agreement, which is why I ask for an option for this to be added. I know that originally the school came and helped at the plots, and this would be no different to that, only for adults instead of children.

I attach my original flyer for your consideration and am happy to discuss this further with yourselves and the landowner should you have any questions.

My idea is that Woolmer Green have a community apothecary and attach links to other communities newsletters so that you can see what this idea could become for our parish.

I am writing to raise concerns about the parking situation outside my property today, which appears to have been caused by visitors attending Kellard House for exams etc and the gate to the village hall car park not being open.

As a result, vehicles were parked all along Bridge Road (where I reside) and throughout the surrounding streets and on grass verges, leading to the village hall creating significant disruption for local residents. The situation was so severe that when I returned home, I was unable to find any parking space nearby and was forced eventually to leave my vehicle across a neighbour's driveway temporarily until a space became available.

This was clearly an avoidable situation had the village hall car park been accessible. I would therefore be grateful if you could explain why the gate was not opened today and whether any measures can be put in place to prevent a recurrence.

In addition, would it be possible for me to be provided with the gate combination or access code? If the car park is inadvertently left locked again in future, I would be willing to open the gate myself to help ease congestion and minimise disruption to residents and visitors alike.

**Replied** to say there is a system in place. The gate is shut but not locked and this was the case on 3rd June. The company should pass this information to attendees.
